#### Proficiency in Theriogenology Award

- Sponsored by Society for Theriogenology
- Senior award available to all Veterinary Schools/Colleges in the U.S. and Canada
- Faculty (ACT diplomats &/or other faculty involved in teaching theriogenology) at each school would select a graduating student.
- The SFT office would be notified by the appropriate deadline (please see attachment) with the name & school.
- The SFT office would be responsible for plaque & shipment to school.
- The award (plaque) would be presented on Senior Awards Day.

#### Criteria for award selection

- Senior student deemed to have illustrated proficiency in clinical theriogenology
- Areas that **could be** considered as criteria
  1. Grades or evaluations in clinical rotation and/or theriogenology electives
  2. Grades or evaluations from didactic theriogenology course or electives.
  3. Practitioner evaluations that relate competence in theriogenology while on externships
  4. Participation in Student SFT organization
  5. Participation in theriogenology based research project
  6. Participation on palpation team
  7. Presentation delivered at SFT meeting

**Proficiency in Theriogenology Award**

- Award available to all veterinary schools/colleges in the U.S. and Canada
- Faculty (ACT diplomats &/or other faculty involved in teaching theriogenology) at each school will select a graduating student.
- One award per year per school/college
- **Since the colleges utilize various schedules for senior rotations, the SFT office makes available the following submission dates in an effort to provide the best fit for your colleges' schedule:**
  - o **If notified by December 1 of each year, plaque will be shipped by Dec 30.**
  - o **If notified by January 1 of each year, plaque will be shipped by Jan 31.**
  - o **If notified by February 1 of each year, plaque will be shipped by Feb 28.**
  - o **If notified by March 1 of each year, plaque will be shipped by Mar 31.**
  - o **If notified by April 1 of each year, plaque will be shipped by Apr 30.**
- The SFT office will provide a plaque to each school for presentation
- The award to be presented on Senior Awards Day.

**Criteria for award selection**

- Must be a **senior** student deemed to have illustrated proficiency in clinical theriogenology
- Use any of the areas listed below in selection process:
  8. Grades or evaluations in clinical rotation and/or theriogenology electives
  9. Grades or evaluations from didactic theriogenology course or electives.
  10. Practitioner evaluations that relate competence in theriogenology while on externships
  11. Participation in Student SFT organization
  12. Participation in theriogenology based research project
  13. Participation on palpation team
  14. Presentation delivered at SFT meeting
